Minutes of Special Council Meeting
December 30, 2022

The Council and Officers of the City of Windy Hills met at 1PM in the Board Room of the Summit Executive Suites, Suite 110. Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 1:01PM and stated that the sole purpose of the meeting was to swear in the new Mayor for his four-year term and the Council Members for their new two-year terms.

Attorney Tim Mayer stated that Don Ryan, Code Enforcement Officer, and Christine Haner, City Clerk, did not need to be sworn in at this time. The Code Enforcement Officer is a one-year term and the City Clerk is a two-year term.

There were a few guests in attendance.

Incoming Mayor, Dr. John Roberts, was sworn in first by City Attorney, Tim Mayer.

The Councilmembers were sworn in collectively afterward.

The Official Oath:

OATH OF OFFICE I do solemnly swear (or affirm, as the case may be) that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and be faithful and true to the Commonwealth of Kentucky so long as I continue a citizen thereof, and that I will faithfully execute, to the best of my ability, the office of Council Member of the City of Windy Hills according to law; and I do further solemnly swear (or affirm) that since the adoption of the present Constitution, I, being a citizen of this State, have not fought a duel with deadly weapons within this State nor out of it, nor have I sent or accepted a challenge to fight a duel with deadly weapons, nor have I acted as second in carrying a challenge, nor aided or assisted any person thus offending, so help me God.

Afterward Mayor Roberts inquired as to whether or not he was assuming Mayoral duties at that moment or on January 1, 2023. The City Attorney responded that his duties commence now that the OATH OF OFFICE was completed.

Councilwoman Greer moved to adjourn the meeting at 1:12 P.M., seconded by Councilwoman Davis and the motion passed unanimously.
