All properties must undergo an external inspection prior to rental. ¹ A check (payable to The City of Windy Hills) for \$150 for the first property and \$75 for each additional property must accompany the annual registration. New property rentals must be registered within 30 days of first rental. If any taxes or past registration fees are due a certificate will be denied. Note: Rental Properties must also be registered with Metro Louisville.
